### **Pinot Noir Rose 2018, Stefan Winter.** 11.5%

### **NV Organic Frizzante Rose, La Jara.** 10% (VEGAN)

### **NV Cremant De Loire, Domaine de Veilloux.** 12% (VEGAN)

Its time to try something a little bit different. Beautifully fresh but with a creamy texture. 100%

### **ORGANIC Pinot Grigio 2019, La Jara.** 13%

This is not your average, washed out pinot. This has depth and flavour. Delicious.

### **Riesling 2020, Saurwein.** 12.5%

Gorgeous aperitif or perfect with fish. One of South Africa's top producers.

### **ORGANIC Viognier, Traminer 2019, Miroglio.** 13.5%

Lovely green and white fruit notes on the nose. Apples, peach, and honeysuckle.

### **Albarino 'Leirana' 2019, Forjas del Salines.** 13%

This wine would be our desert island choice. Of all the wines we have had through the door these past 8 years, nothing compares to this in terms of what the wine brings to your dining experience. From the Salnes Valley in Galicia, blended from 3 individual plots – each vinified separately. Light and youthful but with real elegance and sophistication. You must try this wine.

Marlborough classic from former Cloudy Bay winemaker Eveline Fraser. Very special wine.

<b>ORGANIC Muscadet 2019 Clos Des Grands Primos, Bedouet.</b> 12%	
Classic fish wine from the Loire valley using Melon de Bourgogne grapes.	£32
<b>Sauvignon Blanc "Trinqu'ames" 2019, Domaine La Grange Tiphaine.</b> 12%	
From the Loire valley, a much more restrained and delicate version of this well known grape.	£34
<b>ORGANIC Chardonnay 2016, Emmanuel Giboulet.</b> 13.5%	
Hand picked, Biodynamic Burgundy from the commune of Mancey, in the Mâconnais.	£45

Intensely aromatic, packed with raspberry, black cherry & red fruit. Silky in texture.	£38
<b>Merlot-Malbec 2011, Cosse et Maisonneuve.</b> 13.5%	
70yr old merlot vines, Biodynamically grown in Cahors, seriously classy wine.	£34
<b>ORGANIC Crozes-Hermitage 'Beaumont' 2018, David Reynaud.</b> 13.5%	
100% Syrah. Hand harvested, aged in concrete tanks, no fining, light filtration.

Winemaker Alex Starey has elevated the Keermont estate to the top tier of South African producers. This wine uses only selected batches of hand harvested grape. Vinified separately.	£38
